As a Keg Technician, you will play a crucial role in ensuring the quality and consistency of our beer while contributing to the efficient operation of our production facility. This role requires a strong work ethic, a commitment to quality and cleanliness.

THE RIGHT CANDIDATE WILL:

- Have the ability to work in an alcohol production environment without abusing it
- Possess a team-first attitude and understand the need to be a self-starter
- Maintain brewery and task organization, be detail oriented with the ability to multitask
- Have excellent time management and organizational skills
- Willingness to assist with tasks outside key responsibilities
- Ability to work in a rapidly changing environment
- Above all... results-driven, respectful, careful, and honest

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE (BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO):

- Operate keg filling and cleaning equipment in accordance with standard operating procedures.
- Inspect, clean, and sanitize kegs to maintain high levels of cleanliness and quality.
- Perform and monitor keg filling processes to ensure accuracy, consistency, and efficiency.
- Perform routine maintenance and troubleshooting on keg filling equipment.
- Keep accurate records of keg filling activities, including keg numbers and batch information.
- Collaborate with the brewing team to coordinate keg filling schedules and prioritize production needs.
- Assist in the loading and unloading of kegs from storage areas.
- Maintain a clean and organized work environment to meet quality and safety standards.

- Good communication skills and the ability to follow instructions.
- Physical stamina to lift and move kegs, stand for extended periods, and perform physically demanding tasks.
- Knowledge of safety protocols and a commitment to maintaining a safe work environment.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to work at a fast pace and remain on feet for long periods
- Ability to frequently reach out with hands and arms as well as stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl

- Ability to frequently lift and/or move up to 75 pounds employing traditional lifting methods
- Ability to be frequently exposed to wet conditions and work in extreme cold and heat
- Ability to safely handle chemicals
- Ability to work near moving mechanical parts
