POSITION SUMMARY:

The Cellarperson position is primarily responsible for cellaring operations (as listed below), and will also assist as needed in packaging operations (as listed below). Maintaining a clean and sanitary environment is paramount. This role is a full time position.

THE RIGHT CANDIDATE WILL:

- Have the ability to work in an alcohol production environment without abusing it
- Possess a team-first attitude and understand the need to be a self-starter
- Have basic mechanical skills and the ability to operate applicable machinery, and forklifts
- Maintain brewery and task organization, be detail oriented with the ability to multitask
- Excellent time management and organizational skills
- Willingness to assist with tasks outside key responsibilities
- Communicate efficiently and effectively with team
- Ability to work in a rapidly changing environment
- Above all... results-driven, respectful, careful, and honest

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE (BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO):

- Transferring and centrifuging beer
- Cleaning, maintaining, and sanitizing tanks, equipment, and machinery
- Reporting and addressing any equipment issues immediately
- Maintaining a clean and sanitary work environment
- Yeast harvesting, pitching, and general handling
- Cleaning kegs and filling kegs
- preparing, racking, and extracting from barrels
- Operating a flash pasteurizer
- Keep up to date with and stay informed on daily batch progress
- Contributing ideas and recipes
- Maintaining accurate records
- Abiding by safety rules and regulations
- Possessing a willingness to learn, take direction, and work collaboratively
- Serving as a Brand Ambassador. As a representative, you'll be expected to carry yourself in a professional manner at all times.

REQUIREMENTS:

- At least 2 years previous experience in a similar role at a brewery
- Understanding of physical requirements of this position
- Must put cleanliness and quality before all else
- Experience operating a canning line is not required, but preferred

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to work at a fast pace and remain on feet for long periods
- Ability to frequently reach out with hands and arms as well as stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl
- Ability to frequently lift and/or move up to 75 pounds employing traditional lifting methods
- Ability to be frequently exposed to wet conditions and work in extreme cold and heat
- Ability to safely handle chemicals
- Ability to work near moving mechanical parts
